250,659

calls, chats and texts answered through our 988 Suicide & Crisis Intervention Lifeline, our regional crisis lines and our Native & Strong Lifeline – that’s 250,659 moments where VOAWW offered hope.



160

\$2,000,000

in direct assistance from our Community Resource Centers in Arlington, Lake Stevens and Sky valley went to community members in need. From basic needs, to school supplies, resume building and utility assistance – we provide support during their journey towards independence and stability.
